Rules & Regulations for Field Trials

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B
2. The Club may reserve the right to refuse any entry, except that this shall not apply in terms of the preference in the draw (Regulations J6.g). The Kennel Club must be notified in writing of all such refusals with the Club's reason.
3. The substitution of dogs similarly qualified by the draw date will be allowed up to three days prior to the Trial – the details of which must be included on the original entry form.
4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
5. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
6. Should circumstances so dictate The Club may, in consultation with the Judges, alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
7. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if the time permits before the closing of entries.
8. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
9. DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS: Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.
10. Welfare of Dogs: An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
11. Owners unable to accept a run, even on the reserve list are requested to notify the FT Secretary as soon as possible. Withdrawal from the Trial is covered by Regulation J7f.
12. **All trophies are to be engraved at the Winner's expense, held until required and returned in sparkling clean and good condition for the following season's stake.**
13. Preference in **Open Stakes**: First, Second, Third or Fourth in a 2-day Open stake; or First, Second or Third in a 1-day Open stake; or First in an All-Aged or Novice Stake.
Novice Stakes: Dogs NOT having gained the above awards.
14. The Club expects all those attending Trials to wear clothes in keeping with a shoot day.
15. Members will receive preference in draws.
16. The order of the draw will be the order of running.
17. Videography and photography will only be permitted at the express permission of the Chief Steward and the Host.

Health & Safety Policy for Field Trials

General Policy: To provide adequate awareness of the health and safety risks involved in our activities. Those attending a field trial should be aware of the nature of the activity and informed about any potential hazards.

Responsibilities: Overall responsibility for health and safety is that of the Field Trial Committee and Officers of The Yellow Labrador Club. All those involved with the trial should be responsible for taking care of the health and safety of themselves and others, and to follow instructions with regard to procedures and safety.

Pre-Field Trial Briefing: The Chief Steward will be responsible for safety, supervision and discipline at the Field Trial, and will outline the risks involved before the commencement of the trial. **ONCE THE TRIAL HAS STARTED NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE WITHOUT FIRST NOTIFYING THE CHIEF STEWARD.** It is expected that everyone present will comply with the highest standards of safety and sportsmanship – with respect to quarry, wildlife and the countryside in general.

The Red Flag: This indicates the safe location of spectators and competitors not in the line; and Guns should be aware of the location of the flag.

Dogs: Handlers are responsible for the control of their dogs and ensuring they do not cause injury or accidents.

Topography: The ground used for our Trials is varied and challenging. Heather moorland, ditches, fences, and streams may have to be negotiated. The ground is often rugged and at times walking may be difficult. It is recommended that suitable footwear is worn and appropriate clothing according to the shooting custom. Field Trials take place in all kinds of weather and participants should be dressed appropriately for the conditions. Also a **REASONABLE LEVEL OF FITNESS IS REQUIRED.** The Yellow Labrador Club cannot accept responsibility for injury, loss or damage to person or property however occasioned
